

Whitlock West: hole-in-one homes

If given the choice, some golf lovers would literally live on the course. Now, they actually can.

Situated in the wooded hills surrounding the private Whitlock Golf and Country Club in Hudson, the Whitlock West project will, upon completion, consist of 49 houses in the heart of the new nine-hole course added in 2008.

It's all part of Whitlock's massive facelift, which will also include a brand new club house, leading up to the club's 100th anniversary in 2012. "We wanted to do a project near Montreal where people could live and have fun and enjoy the golf course," says Whitlock West general manager René Schubert.

Schubert says that there is already quite a bit of interest in the development with 40 percent of the homes having been pre-sold. And though they may be located on a golf course, Schubert says



these ideal homes are not just for golfers. "A lot of people buy on the golf course because they know behind their home is going to be green in the summer and white in the winter," he says.

"It's a nice view. It's natural, and you don't have a neighbour in your backyard that you have to look at every time you go outside."

In addition to its setting, Schubert says the development is also unique for its all-inclusiveness. When a home is purchased, the buyer then meets with interior and exterior designers to insure that nothing is left incomplete when it is time to move in.

"Usually when people buy a home, they have to do everything by themselves," says Schubert. In this case, the landscaping is included in the price – as well as a membership to the Club. Services such as cutting grass, snow removal, etc., will be provided for an annual fee.
